April brings state testing, which can be a stressful time for many students. Just remind your child to RELAX.



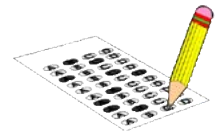
R- Read the question carefully, then reread the passage or the problem

E- Examine every answer choice before you choose your answer

L- Label key words in the question or passage

A- Always check your work!

X- X-out answers that you know are wrong
