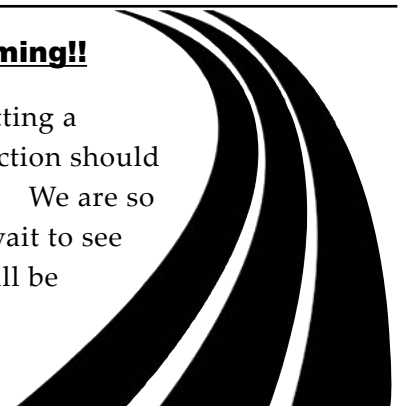

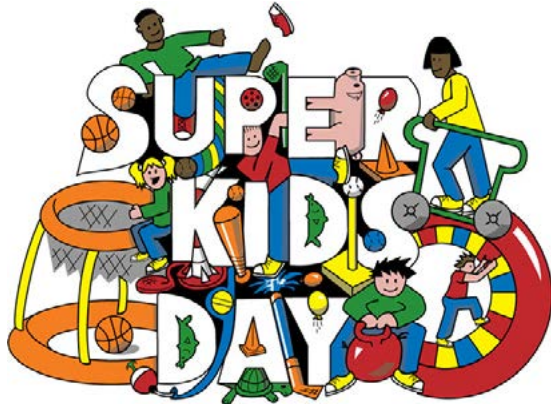
New Track Coming!!
